

OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY OF THE DANUBE WITNER SCHOOL 2016

The Danube Winter School is taking place in Novi Sad and Andrevlje at Fruška Gora between 16th and 21st of March 2016. The official opening ceremony for the Danube Winter School took place on Wednesday, 16th March 2016, at the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad at 4:00 PM. The participants arrived at the Faculty and were greeted by our respected speakers prof. dr Ivana Živančević Sekeruš, Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy - University of Novi Sad, mr. Vladimir Pavlov, Secretary of Provincial Secretariat for Science and Technological Development - Government of AP Vojvodina, mag. Johannes Irschik, Director of the Austrian Cultural Forum in Belgrade, prof. dr Ivan Jordović, Head of the Department of History, Faculty of Philosophy - University of Novi Sad. After the opening ceremony, the participants were invited to a cocktail at the Faculty and after that they were on their way to Andrevlje and the Congress Center CePTOR, their accomodating and working space for the next five days. After they arrived, the members of the DAREC team and a representative of the Center for Historic Research, presented the Danube Area Research Center, the European Danube Academy and the Center for Historic Research, Faculty of Philosophy - University of Novi Sad, respectively.

The Danube Winter School is gathering a group of 25 youth researchers from 12 countries of the Danube region. Through different workshops and lectures, different features and options in the Danube region will be emphasized and awareness of the importance of the issues will be developed, also challenges, strengths and opportunities in the Danube region will be mentioned, as well as the development of knowledge and obtaining information on the Danube region.
